You can return your ballot in one of many secure ballot drop boxes around Somerset County by **close of polls on election day**.

You can mail your ballot to the Board of Elections (NO postage necessary) **postmarked on or before election day and received 6 days after the close of polls.**

You can deliver your ballot in person to the Board of Elections no later than **close of polls on election day**. You or your bearer will need to show ID when surrendering the ballot

The deadline for registered voters who wish to change their party affiliation was 55 days prior (**by April 13th**) to the Primary. If you would like to change for future primary elections click here for the form:

That affiliation can be changed at any time after the June Primary.
